• Healthy Hunger is going strong. The kids love fun lunches and are excited for the new restaurant additions. We have some Year 8/9 students in the Healthy Hunger Club to help deliver the orders to the classrooms – thank you! We are still looking for parent volunteers to help at KH and RC. The volunteer commitment is usually 30 minutes every Wednesday. Look for the signup genius link to volunteer. There was a change for the Edo location that we use. All of the Edo menus will have more offerings. If you have already done your future Edo orders, maybe go back and just edit them. If there's something that you want to add on to that that lunch.

There is no Healthy Hunger at the High School Campus and these are the main reasons why: Student Council over at EC runs their own lunch concession and the directly benefit their Student Council. High school students can leave the campus over lunch. Healthy Hunger has a minimum order for delivery, otherwise there are additional fees and difficult for a restaurant to coordinate delivery to 3 different locations.

- The first fundraiser is the pumpkin silent auction happening at the Knob Hill Halloween Dance. This is a longstanding tradition for Calgary Arts Academy at the Knob Hill, Halloween Dance. All of the classes get to create unique pumpkins in various ways, whether it's carving, painting, decorating, adding stuff to them, constructing things out of pumpkins, and then those pumpkins, then get put up for auction at the dance and you get to take home a wonderful pumpkin.
- The second fundraiser is created by Kids Arts Gift (Kidsca) and this is different then the art fundraiser that's happening at Jubilee. This fundraiser is where students can take home a template, and create their own piece of art. Families can go online and order mugs ,puzzles, cards with their art that they've created. Items will be ready for pickup and distributed just before Christmas.
