# 1. Call to order

Meeting called to order by Christy Ford at 6:31 p.m.

# 2. Approval of Agenda

# 4. Chairperson's Report

It was noted that the Bow Valley Meats fundraiser was a huge success. Volunteer Coordinator Erin Wright has been working hard to get volunteers lined up for various roles.

# 5. Principal's Report

#### Michelle Stonehouse (Principal)

The Jube video was circulated in December. The winter clothing drive was a success. \$4,175.00 was raised during the loonie/twoonie drive, which went towards helping twelve families.

The return to school is still scheduled for January 11 for the time being. The final decision from the provincial government, however, will be announced on Thursday.

A high school information night is being held on January 13 for anyone looking for further details on Year 10.

It was noted that parking is currently a challenge at the Knob Hill Campus due to the snow piles. A reminder was given that the future bus zone on the south side is a non-parking zone.

## a. School Council Advocacy

There is work ongoing to advocate for charter schools in the province. There are some grassroots campaigns underway to have charter schools treated the same as private schools as opposed to public schools. Further information will be shared with the CAA community and parent body, and all are encouraged to get involved in advocating for charter schools.

#### 7. New Business

# a. Babysitting Course/Home Alone Course

Kids are required to be 12 (or turning 12 within the calendar year) in order to attend the babysitting course. The babysitting course is scheduled for February 6, and registration will be limited to 10. Additional courses may be added if the interest is strong. A 75% pass grade on the final exam is required.

CAA already has the instructor package for the home alone course. A call for volunteers to teach the home alone course was issued and will go out in the next CAA newsletter.

# b. Teacher Appreciation Lunch, February Break PD Day

The next teacher appreciation lunch will be scheduled in conjunction with the February PD day.

#### 8. Parent Discussion and Questions

Clarification was requested on why there is a movement to integrate the charter schools into the private system. The issue is one of misunderstanding and misinformation – the movement is focused on petitioning the provincial government to stop supporting private schools and charter schools have erroneously been lumped in with private schools.
